Curfew Procedure

*All Semi-Final and Championship games are exempt from the curfew rule.

*For the purposes of the curfew rule, game time commences when the warm-up clock begins.

*If at any time during a game, the game time remaining to play equals the amount of time remaining until the curfew, the game will revert to running time for the duration of the game.

*If during the last minute of the 3rd period of a game that is running time due to the curfew rule the goal differential is 1 goal or less, the game will revert back to stop time for the last minute so long as the goal differential remains at 1 goal or less. During such a game, anytime the goal differential returns to 2 goals or more, the clock will revert to running time immediately with the scoring of the goal that restores the 2 goal or more differential. Should the goal differential return to 1 goal or less, the clock will revert back to stop time immediately upon the scoring of the goal that restores the 1 goal or less differential situation.

*Both teams will still be permitted to use their timeout during all situations.

*The game will end upon the expiration of the game clock.

* The on-ice officials will have sole discretion in determining whether or not to extend the curfew should a delay occur due to extenuating circumstances (e.g. player injury).

*In all games where the Curfew procedures outlined above are imposed, the game will end upon the expiration of the game clock.
